Legislation Update:

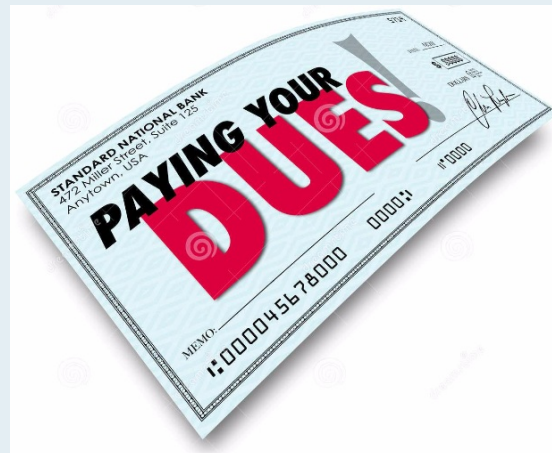
